In his five seasons as the head coach of the Heidelberg University men's basketball team, Andy Bucheit has helped restore pride and purpose within the program. By recruiting outstanding student-athletes who have the desire to succeed in the classroom, in the community and on the court, Bucheit's squad has climbed the standings in the Ohio Athletic Conference.

Bucheit and his coaching staff understand what it takes to win. Between playing and coaching careers of assistant Tim Kaiser and Bucheit himself, the Heidelberg staff has combined for three conference regular season titles, four conference tournament crowns and six NCAA Tournament appearances. The staff has been to the Final Four one time.
