In his 12 seasons as the head coach of the Heidelberg University men's basketball team, Andy Bucheit has helped restore pride and purpose within the program. By recruiting outstanding student-athletes who have the desire to succeed in the classroom, in the community and on the court, Bucheit's squad has climbed the standings in the Ohio Athletic Conference.

Bucheit and his coaching staff understand what it takes to win. Between playing and coaching careers of current and former asisstants and Bucheit himself, the Heidelberg staff has combined for 9 conference regular season titles, 9 conference tournament crowns and 15 NCAA Tournament appearances. The trio has been to the Sweet Sixteen four times, Elite Eight once and the Final Four two times.

Heidelberg competes in the Ohio Athletic Conference -- one of the toughest leagues in Division III in all sports. Each season, the OAC has several teams ranked in the Top 25.
